Sabeeha Rehman is the blogger, public speaker and author of the memoir, *Threading My Prayer Rug, One Woman's Journey from Pakistani Muslim to American Muslim*. The book received international and national awards. She has co-authored her new book with Walter Ruby titled *We Refuse to be Enemies. How Muslims and Jews Can Make Peace, One Friendship at a Time*. She is an op-ed contributor to the Houses of Worship column of the *Wall Street Journal*. Her articles have been published in the *New York Daily News*, *Forward*, *Salon.com*, *Tiferet*, *Patheos.com* and *The Baltimore Sun*.

Sabeeha migrated from Pakistan to the United States in 1971, after her marriage to a Pakistani doctor in New York. She holds a Masters in Healthcare Administration, and has had a 25-year career as a hospital executive in New York, New Jersey, and Saudi Arabia. When her grandson Omar was diagnosed with autism, she left her career as a healthcare executive, and devoted herself to serving families affected by autism. In 2008, she co-founded the National Autism Association New York Metro chapter and served as its President from 2008-2011.

As a public speaker, Sabeeha has spent several decades engaging in interfaith dialogue, including keynote speaker. She has lectured on the art of memoir writing at academic institutions, and is a moderator for the Yorkville Writing Circle of the New York Public Library.

Sabeeha lives in New York City with her husband Khalid, a retired Hematologist/Oncologist. They have two sons and four grandchildren.
